According to a July 2015 Report published by the **Virginia Economic Development Program** South Korea's defense budget is the 11th largest in the world at \$32.8 billion in 2013. The defense budget has grown continually in proportion to increasing GDP over the last 5 years, and is estimated to be \$37.5 billion in 2015 in order to support military operational expenses and fund defense capacity improvement projects. 70% of the defense budget is spent on weapons purchases while the remainder is mostly used for R&D expenses.
